

CORNWALL YOUTH BRASS BAND. Registered Charity No.1116586. RULES.

1. Any musician aged 21 years and under, playing a standard Brass Band Instrument, who meets a sufficient level of musicianship decided by the Trustees and ascertained by means of an Audition may join the Band.
2. An Annual Fee shall be payable by all Musicians in the Band.
3. Any Musician of The Cornwall Youth Brass Band acting in a manner which, in the opinion of the Trustees, is detrimental to the proper conduct or reputation of the Band may be suspended or asked to leave the Band.
4. A commitment is required from Musicians to regularly attend the courses and rehearsals of the Band, always bearing in mind, that commitments with parent Bands will be given priority. A prior apology is required for non attendance.
5. During Residential Courses responsibility for Health & Safety, Pastoral Care, Welfare and Security are under the control of The Cornwall County Council Welfare Team Members resident on the Course. Their instructions and guidance must be adhered to at all times.
6. Participation in the Residential Courses will be at the discretion of the Trustees and following payment of the requisite Fee.
7. Parents or guardians of Musicians under the age of eighteen participating in the Band Courses, whether residential or not, must complete the Consent Form provided by the Band specifying the conditions under which the Musician may or may not leave the Course premises.
8. The consumption of alcohol, smoking of tobacco or the possession and use of drugs is not permitted by Musicians on any premises being used by the Band.
9. The Trustees can accept no responsibility for the loss of, or any damage to, any possessions or equipment belonging to Musicians whilst attending any rehearsal, course or function of the Band. Nor can any responsibility accepted for any accidents, howsoever caused, to or involving Band Musicians.
10. Music issued to Musicians remains the property of the Band and must be returned in good condition after use.
11. The Uniform for Band Musicians at Concerts is white shirt or blouse, black trousers (not jeans), black shoes and socks and black bow tie.
12. All Musicians must adhere to, and are covered by, the requirements and conditions of the Band's Child Protection Policy, a full copy of which is available on the Band's Web Site at, [www.cybb.co.uk](http://www.cybb.co.uk) or from the Secretary.
13. No Musician may take or cause to be taken by any means any photograph or image of any other members of the Band with the intention of exhibiting them on any Social Networking Internet Site, nor may they set up any entry on such a site in the name of The Cornwall Youth Brass Band.
14. At a specified Rehearsal each year Musicians will invited to elect from amongst their number a male and female musician to represent all the Musicians of the Band at the Meetings of the Board of Trustees of The Cornwall Youth Brass Band for one year. They will be invited to attend the meetings as Members of the Band and contribute to the business of the Meeting, but will not be entitled to vote on any resolutions.
15. Acceptance of an invitation to join the Band is deemed an agreement to be bound by these Rules.
16. These Rules are subject to alteration and addition at any time by the Trustees of the Band.
